- **LIMITS:** Carries Eliza Furnace Trail over Bates Street
- **LENGTH:** 60' Simple span
- **WIDTH:** 30' full structure width; (Trail usage only)

SCOPE OF WORK:

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission (PTC) is designing this bridge replacement as part of the Mon-Fayette Expressway. The City of Pittsburgh will construct the bridge replacement. PennDOT design criteria is being utilized. Bridge is in an urban/trail setting. Detour routing needs to be provided for trail users during construction. Some approach work at either end of the new bridge (east/west along the trail may be required to tie in new bridge elevations).

STATUS: Final Design underway by the PTC.
