## PROJECT SPECIFICS:

- **LIMITS:** Main Street to Penn Circle
- **LENGTH:** 7,900 feet (1.50 miles)
- **WIDTH:** Mostly 36' wide cartway with 12' sidewalks
- **LOCATION:** East end of the City of Pittsburgh (see Location link below).

## SCOPE OF WORK:

A “Corridor Study” for this project is currently being conducted to help determine the order and magnitude of the improvements needed for this high-traffic street. Once the Corridor Study is complete, the project may include upgraded traffic signals and street lighting, new roadway concrete or asphalt, special sidewalks, special pavement in crosswalks, and aesthetic enhancements. Detailed traffic control and construction sequencing will also be required. PWSA upgrades of waterline system and separation of storm and sanitary flow may be part of the project. Coordination with private utility upgrades will also be required.

**STATUS:** Corridor Study underway.

**SCHEDULE:** Corridor Study to be complete Winter 2008-2009.  
Design and Construction of segments to follow.
